The UK IT Industry Employment Outlook

Used internationally as a bellwether of labour market trends, the Net Employment Outlook (NEO) — calculated by subtracting the percentage of employers who anticipate reductions to staffing levels from those who plan to hire — now stands at +48%.




Changes over time
